1 Nakapagpapalinaw ng mata



Sagana ang mga *organic* na itlog sa iba't ibang bitamina at mineral katulad ng *Vitamin A*, *Vitamin E* at *Selenium*. Taglay din ng mga *organic* na itlog ang *lutein* at *zeaxanthin* na siyang mahalaga sa pagpapanatili at pag-suporta sa kalusugan ng ating mga mata.

2 Nagpapatibay ng immune system



Ang mga bitamina tulad ng *Vitamin A*, *Vitamin B-12* at *Selenium* na nasa itlog ay susi sa pagpapanatili ng kalusugan ng *immune system* gaya ng sa mata. Ang *yolk* ng mga itlog ay sagana sa *Vitamin D* na tinatawag ding '*sunshine vitamin*'. May mahalagang papel ang bitaminang ito sa pagkakaroon ng *calcium* at *phosphorus* na siyang nagpapanatili ng malusog na buto at ngipin. Kabilang na rin dito ang pagpapalusog ng mga kalamnan at pagpapanatili ng kalusugan ng *immune system*.

3 Nakapagpapapayat



Ang ganitong klase ng itlog ay madalas na kinakain ng mga taong gustong magpapababa ng timbang dahil mababa ang mga ito sa *calories* at puno ng mataas na kalidad ng protina. Dahil dito, mainam ito na idagdag sa iba't ibang klase ng pagdidiyeta na makatutulong sa pagkontrol ng timbang. Ang pagkain ng itlog ay makatutulong din sa pagbabawas ng lebel ng *glucose* na mayroong maraming pangmatagalang benepisyo.

4 Nagbibigay ng enerhiya



Ang mga itlog ay naglalaman ng mga nutrisyon na kailangan ng katawan upang makapagbigay ng enerhiya.

5 Nakapagpapaganda ng balat

Ang ilang bitamina at mineral na nasa itlog ay nakatutulong sa pagtaguyod ng malusog na balat at makaiwas sa pagkasira ng mga tisyu ng katawan. Ang malakas na *immune system* ay nakatutulong din sa isang tao na magkaroon ng maayos na pakiramdam.



6 Nakatutulong sa mga buntis

Nagtataglay ang mga itlog ng *folic acid* na siyang makatutulong sa pag-iwas na magkaroon ng mga *congenital disease* katulad ng *spina bifida* na maaaring makapahamak sa mga buntis at kanilang anak.



7 Nakapagpapatalas ng utak

Mayroong mga bitamina at mineral ang itlog na kailangan ng utak at *nervous system* upang epektibong makaganap ang mga ito.



8 Nagpapababa ng tsansa ng sakit sa puso

Ang pagkain ng itlog ay nakatutulong sa pagdagdag ng *high-density lipoprotein level* o kung tawagin ay mabuting kolesterol. Isa itong rason kung bakit nakakapagpapababa o nakakapagpapawala ng tsansa ng pagkakaroon ng sakit sa puso ang itlog.



9 Nagpapalakas ng kalamnan

Ang protina na nasa itlog ay nakatutulong sa pagpapanatili at pag-aayos ng tisyu ng katawan at kasama na rito ang kalamnan.

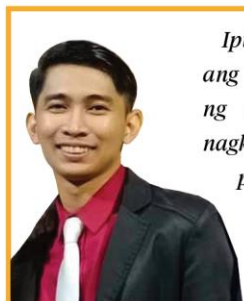

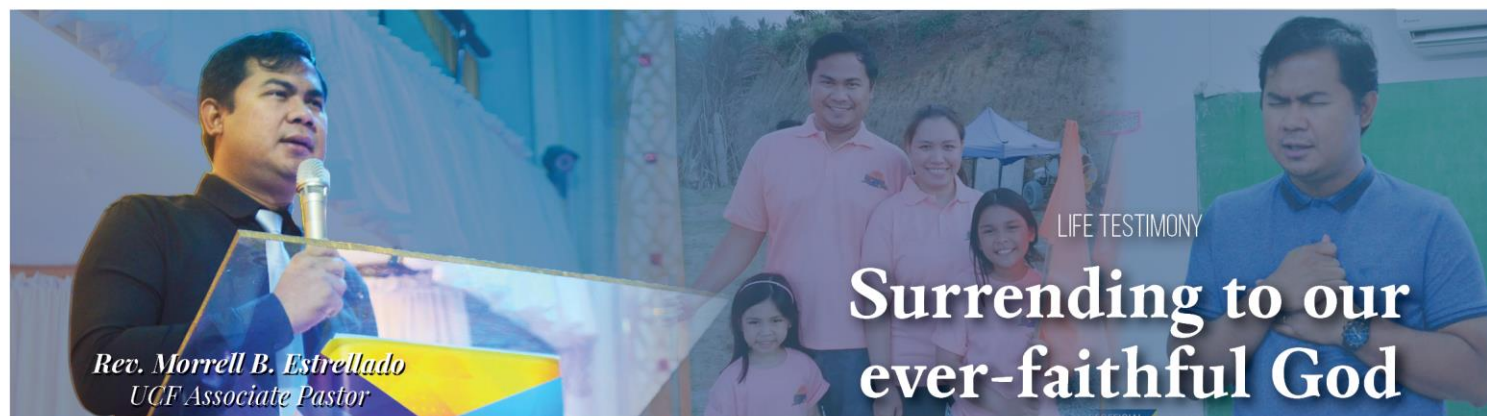

A life that is anchored to the Lord is a life worth living. There may be challenges, problems, and trials that come our way, but if we put our trust to the Lord, He is always there to guide, strengthen, and encourage us to continue and win every fight. Here is a testimony of one of our dear pastors on how the Lord has been faithful to him after surrendering his life to the Lord,

“My heart cried out to Him and suddenly, I felt the presence of God that embraced me, which I found very comforting and peaceful. And from that moment, I surrendered my life to Jesus.

Since I was a child, I knew God. Actually, I grew up attending church every Sunday morning. Gumigising ako nang maaga to go to church to sing praises and to hear God's Word. But a time came when my heart and my mind were corrupted by earthly things: lies, pride, envy, anger, rebellion, and lust. Pakiramdam ko ay yumayakap ako sa karimlan na alam kong mali pero hindi ko mapigilan. I was thinking, 'Wala namang nakakakita. Wala namang nakakaalam.'

But God knew and saw all of it. Until one night, God dealt with me. After committing a sin, I heard a voice saying, 'Hindi ka ba napapagod?' I felt so guilty. Then, I started to pray to God, asking for forgiveness. My heart cried out to Him and suddenly, I felt the presence of God that embraced me, which I found very comforting and

peaceful. And from that moment, I surrendered my life to Jesus.

And from then on, God mightily used me to glorify His Name. I was involved in different ministries: UCF Band, UCA Chapel Band, and Youth Fellowship. I have also led many young people closer to God.

Last 2004, a big trial happened in my family and my mom decided to leave UCF with my little brother due to some reasons. I chose to remain as I knew that God is talking to me here in UCF, and He called me in this church. From then on, I got more involved in the ministries, most especially in evangelism.

In 2007, I was left by my discipler as he wanted to pursue something personal in his life. It was another great trial for me, but Ptr. William and Ptr. James were used by God to encourage me to

continue in the ministry.

In the year 2009, I had already been working for three years, but it seemed nothing is happening in my career and life because the lives of my colleagues in college and work were comparably greater than my life as they were working outside the Philippines. Knowing those, my plan was to just work abroad. I tried to apply many times, but I failed. I started to question God, but it is said in His Word that He has good plans for my life as I follow Him. The answer that I got from God was, 'Wait!'

One night, I had a counselling with Ptr. William and he told me to just continue applying. I obeyed consistently until I got a job offer which surprised me because I do not need to work abroad! And most of all, the job is a flexible work from home. This made me continue in the ministry while doing my work. This convinced me that God's plan is far better than the plan that I have for myself. From then on, I got more and more involved in the ministries, most especially in evangelism and discipleship.



As Rev. Morrell Estrellado continues to faithfully serve our Lord, his life also becomes a blessing to the people around him, radiating the love that he also has for the Lord.

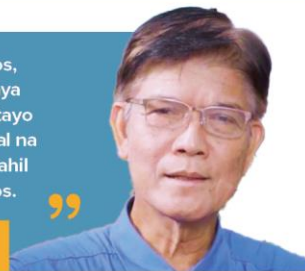

HEBREWS 10:14-18 (NKJV)

Sabi sa Hebrews 10:14-18, 'For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.' If you could understand this verse, ang perfection na sinasabi ng Salita ng Diyos dito is only to those who are being sanctified. The message is very clear. It is not for everybody. Yes, Jesus died for all, but that offering was intended to those who are being sanctified.

If you read the Scriptures, you would understand kung sino ang mga tinatawag na sanctified. Ang word na 'sanctity' o 'sanctification' is the same word as the word 'holiness', the same word used as 'righteousness'. Sa Bible, ang tatlong salita na ito become one

word. In short, hindi puwedeng holy ka pero hindi ka righteous. Hindi puwedeng righteous ka nang hindi ka sanctified. Hindi ito parang isang stage kung saan ito muna ang kukunin ko—magiging sanctified muna ako, then later na ako magiging holy, later na ako magiging righteous. Hindi siya puwedeng hiwa-hiwalay. Ang tatlong kataga na ito ay laging magkakasama. At ang nagbigay noong tatlong iyon ay walang iba kung hindi si Jesus. Wala ring ibang source.

Hindi ka puwedeng maging righteous on your own. Hindi ka puwedeng maging holy on your own. Hindi ka puwedeng maging sanctified on your own. It is always through Jesus Christ. Ang tatlong bagay na ito ay ang pundasyon. Napakahalaga na maintindihan natin na ang bawat anak ng Diyos na tinawag Niya ay sina-sanctify Niya.

Dahil binigay ninyo ang buhay Ninyo sa Panginoon, it is by choice not by compulsion. You have given willingly. Noong binigay mo ang buhay mo sa Panginoon, ang sabi mo 'Panginoon, simula sa araw na ito ang buhay ko ay Iyo. Ikaw na ang aking Diyos. Ikaw na ang aking Panginoon. Ikaw din ang aking Tagapagligtas.'

Noong ang Diyos ay tinanggap mo sa iyong puso, may nangyari. Nagkaroon ng tinatawag na indwelling. Ngayon, si Kristo ay hindi na nasa pader na katulad ng ginagawa ng iba. Hindi na nasa pitaka. Hindi na nakatayo na parang estatwa. Si Kristo ngayon ay nandito na sa ating mga puso. Iyan ang tinatawag na indwelling. Pag-aari na tayo ng ating Diyos.
